Introduction

The aim of this training is to provide existing skippers with the knowledge and information they require to operate effectively and safely as Guard Vessel Skippers. The training will build upon existing knowledge and experience and develop capabilities to enable them to operate effectively within the role.

Training Content

The programme will deal with all aspects of guard vessel operations. The following subjects are covered:

- The purpose and role of a guard vessel- what is expected from skippers when working in the field to achieve safe and effective operations 24 hour 7 days a week
- Review of the types of vessel used including typical specifications and how they are prepared for tour of operations in relation to sailing instructions, markings, on-board equipment and facilities
- The health and safety aspects of the role-reference will be made to relevant policies, procedures and codes of practice.
- Communications throughout all operations
- Dealing with emergency situations
